Letter from Prein & Newhof informing the Village of an offer to perform a sanitary sewer study  
within the township.

We received a citizen's request to look into a street light on the corner of E. Maple and Maple  
Circle. This request was given to the street committee to investigate.

Public works:

1) 35 applications have been received for the Public Works position.

Parks: The swing set has been ordered and payment will be due the first of April and installation  
expected in May.

Streets: A sidewalk in front of the high school could be a costly and involved project. It is the  
recommendation of the street committee to drop the issue. There is a sidewalk on the opposite  
side of the road and crossing guards could be used to help students cross safely.

Ordinance/Zoning: A public hearing for Zoning Map approval has been set for February 19 at  
6:00 pm at the Lawrence Library.

Water: (Messner/Rogers) Motion to adopt Ordinance #39 – Cross Connection Ordinance. An  
ordinance regulating cross connections with the public water supply system. Unanimously  
approved. The ordinance will appear in the February 8<sup>th</sup> issue of the Crescent.

Well head protection project was reviewed by the water committee and recommended to place  
on hold indefinitely.
