(Phoenix/Twiss) Motion to approve the minutes of June 6, 2000. All in favor - motion carried.

(Twiss/Wyant) Motion to approve the June 2000 Bill Package. Roll Call: Ayes - all. Motion carried.

Ralph Weessies discussed the Library. 1) Volunteer workers are appreciated.
2) Library open house is coming up.
3) Attempt another millage election to maintain District Library Status. If millage fails then the library reverts back to a local library.
4) Many good programs offered for all ages.

Sue Sanders, Librarian, spoke to the Council and told of her background and qualification.

Communications:

1) Received membership renewal from Council of Governments (COG). 1) COG is looking into reorganizing and the vote to reorganize is coming up shortly. 2) Reorganizing would increase budget to \$180,000. 3) Dues would increase. 4) Another tier of Government. 5) Hiring of high paid manager. 6) Road commission would not be part of COG.

President Stevenson recommended against re-organization of COG. (Phoenix/Guidarini) Motion to support Stevenson in voting against the re-organization of COG. All member in favor. Motion carried.

(Twiss/Guidarini) Motion to pay the annual dues of \$100.00 to remain an active member of COG for fiscal year 2000. Roll call vote: Ayes - All present. Motion carried.

Received a letter from the Liquor Control Commission regarding the Harvester.

Public Works:

1) Bike path has been resurfaced.
2) Local streets (Maple Cir., Cherry and S. Church) have been slurry coated.

Public Safety: The "Smart Cart" (Car speed indicator) will be back in the Village. There is a great demand for the cart throughout the county. Many favorable responses were received in regard to the placement of the Smart Cart.

Streets: Railroad crossing on West Maple is scheduled to be completed in Mid-July.

Water: Yard Sale and Trash pickup all set for June 24 and 26.
