Communications: The Household Hazardous Waste Report was reviewed. 2003 was the best year ever. Over 5,000 county residents dropped off 155 tons of hazardous materials for safe disposal – a 21% increase over the previous year. For the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter, Climax village had 2 households who dropped off hazardous materials. A total of 11 households used the facility for 2003.

A letter from the Parks Foundation of Kalamazoo County requesting a letter of support for a grant application to the MDOT. This is in reference to the trailway across Kalamazoo County which will connect the Kal-Haven, Battle Creek Linear, and Portage Bicentennial Trails. No Action was taken on the letter of support.
