January 4, 2000

(Twiss/Messner) Motion to approve the minutes of December 21, 1999. Approved - all present.

(Messner/Twiss) Motion to approve the December 31, 1999 Treasurer's Report.

Roll Call: Ayes - all.

Communications: Received a letter from Steve Leuty regarding the update on waste haulers that have submitted their annual applications. The letter stated that Waste Management and Best Way have not submitted an application.

Public Works:

- 1) Receiving quotes for the resurfacing of the Bike path and Tennis Court.
- 2) Christmas trees will be picked up until January 17th. Residents will be notified to place trees on the curbside. Clerk directed to place notice in paper.

Ordinance: 2nd reading of Ordinance 37: Climax Village Loitering and Emergency Curfew Ordinance. No changes or corrections were noted. The ordinance becomes effective February 3, 2000.

(Twiss/Messner) Motion to adopt Ordinance 37: Climax Village Loitering and Emergency Curfew Ordinance, to become effective February 3, 2000. Ayes: K. Guidarini, B. Twiss, BJ Wyant, S. Messner and D. Stevenson. Nays: None. Absent: D. Guidarini, L. Phoenix.

Water: Fluoridation of water system was researched and presented to the Council. Fluorine is very corrosive and dangerous to handle. This would require special handling and additional training of village employees. Also: permits, detailed public information and a vote of the community would be recommended. Future consideration was tabled.

Rust filtration system was also researched and found it to be extremely expensive. An alternative could be to have deeper wells if a deeper aquifer is present. A Grant could also be looked into to finance the filtration system.

Councilman Bill Twiss presented to Councilwoman Katherine Guidarini a memorable plaque for her efforts to assure the Village was prepared for the new year. It was one of Bill's fine work of match stick art.
