(Twiss/Blayden) Motion to approve the minutes of August 6, 2002 without exception. Unanimously approved.

(Twiss/Phoenix) Motion to approve the August 2002 Bill Package totaling \$16,733.67. Roll Call: Unanimously approved.

(Phoenix/Blayden) Motion to approve the July 31, 2002 Treasurer's Report. Major Streets = \$141,901.14; Local Streets = \$31,664.86; General Fund = \$186,988.12; Water Fund = \$103,485.22; Perpetual Care Fund = \$11,406.63 Totals = \$475,445.97. Roll Call Vote: Unanimously approved.

Guests: Mike Wesaw, of the American Legion, requested the use of the park to hold a special ceremony on September 11, 2002 at 12:00. There will be no march along the street.

(Phoenix/Twiss) Motion to allow the American Legion to have use of the park on 9/11/02. Unanimously approved.

Communications: The Council has received three responses to fill the vacancy on the Council. These people will be invited to attend the next Council meeting.

Public Works:

- 1) Traffic signs are being stolen and damaged. There has been a group of people loitering in the park creating large amounts of litter and damage to the fence. Lights will be added to park to remove the dark hiding areas. Damage to the new seal coat on Main and Maple Streets due to drivers spinning the car's tires and doing donuts in the intersections has taken place. Licenses plate numbers have been noted and submitted to the Sheriff Department.
