(Twiss/Rogers) Motion to approve the minutes of July 1, 2003 without exception. Unanimously approved.

(Blayden/Twiss) Motion to approve the July 2003 Bill Package totaling \$24,048.58. Roll Call vote: Unanimously approved.

(Twiss/Thompson) Motion to approve the June 30, 2003 Treasurer's Report. Major Streets = \$128,043.55; Local Streets = \$17,494.87; General Fund = \$187,090.38; Water Fund = \$109,560.97; Perpetual Care Fund = \$11,406.63; Totals = \$453,596.40. Roll Call Vote: Unanimously approved.

Public Works:

- 1) Individuals from outside of the Village are dumping material in the well field brush pile. Also noted are non-residents dropping off brush and limbs at various residents homes. Options to discourage the dumping would be to A) install a chain link fence around the well field area. B) Place material in the enclosed area of the #3 well field. C) Help educate residents through notices placed in the Crescent. President Stevenson will place a letter in the Crescent.
- 2) Markers by a resident have been placed along the road in the Village's Right-of-way. These could be a potential hazard. Checking with the Village Attorney for direction.
- 3) Kubota tractor is in for equipment enhancements.
- 4) Mosquito control is still in process. Supplier is back ordered on the product.

Parks/Library/Cemetery: Discussed updating and modernizing the cemetery plot records. The system we have is very old and confusing in determining available sites. Forwarded to Cemetery Committee.

Ordinances: Ordinance committee to contact Sheriff on various ordinance violations.

A few items are still left in residents yards from the trash pickup. Clerk will contact BFI to get their explanation for leaving items. If they are listed as un-collectable items, the resident will be contacted to remove the items from their yard. (125 Cherry, 231 Cherry, 210 N. Church, 122 W. Maple)
